Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Burkett, Contner, Muir, Richardson, Rudolph.

Motion by Contner, second by Richardson to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Burkett, second by Rudolph to approve the minutes of October 5, 2015. Motion carried unanimously.

Engineer Wade Weiss updated the board on equipment purchases that he discussed at last week's meeting.

Motion by Contner second by Richardson to approve claims for payment with an addition of a bill submitted by Goodwin & Son Painting for power washing of the courthouse in the amount of \$15,845.00. Motion carried unanimously.

Jefferson City Administrator Mike Palmer provided his monthly update of city projects and development activities.

Chief Deputy Jack Williams discussed with the board a "Social Host" Ordinance. This ordinance would inflict civil penalties on landowners allowing underage parties.

Motion by Rudolph, second by Contner to approve Governor's Traffic Safety Bureau State and Community Highway Safety Grant PAP 16-402-MOOP Task 26-50-00 for the period of November 1, 2015 through September 30, 2016. Motion carried unanimously. The funds will be used for a mobile speed sign.

Overnight travel was informally approved for Mindy Durlam and Pierre Kellogg to attend the Iowa NENA Fall Conference for State 911 Training in Des Moines. Also approved was Lesa Seil to attend the Uniform Crime Reporting Training also in Des Moines.

Motion by Richardson, second by Rudolph to accept the Treasurer's Investment & Driver's License Report for September. Motion carried unanimously.

At 10:00 a.m., motion by Richardson, second by Contner to adjourn to a drainage meeting for DD33 Completion hearing. Motion carried unanimously. The board returned to regular session at 10:30 a.m.
